This Week: : Christmas Day The Nativity of Our Lord Jesus Christ (B)

Midnight Mass

First Reading Isaiah 9:1-7

Isaiah foretells the birth of the Messiah, the one who will come to save God's people. His reign will last for ever.

Second Reading Titus 2:11-14

The revelation of God's grace in Jesus Christ challenges us to live lives worthy of God.

Gospel Luke 2:1-14

Jesus is born in Bethlehem, and the angel of the Lord announces news of the birth to shepherds in the field: already, the good news is beginning to spread.

Mass during the day

First Reading Isaiah 52:7-10

Isaiah foretells the coming of the Lord: it is to be a time of great rejoicing, and all the ends of the earth will see the salvation of God.

Second Reading Hebrews 1:1-6

All the prophecies of old have been fulfilled by God in the sending of his Son, Jesus Christ. All the angels worship Jesus, who sits at the right hand of God.

Gospel John 1:1-18

John reflects on the mystery of the incarnation, where the eternal Word of God becomes flesh and lives among us. In him, we see God's glory.
