#### My Dear People

As I was reflecting on what to share with you this week I looked back on what was happening during the week. I am sure you will agree with me there were so many events both near at home and far away grabbed our attention and perhaps made us think and reflect what all those events meant.

To begin with last Saturday while we enjoyed a wonderful South Indian Cultural evening in aid of the Lenten Project supporting four worthy causes, what grabbed the attention of the media was Pope Francis' visit to Lesbos and his return with twelve Syrian refugees that evening, giving them some hope. Pope Francis certainly by his life shows the Mercy of God in everything he does. During the week the nation mourned the death of Victoria Wood and the music lovers mourned the death of singer Prince, both at a very young age. Thursday we celebrated the 90th birthday of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II and during our morning Mass we prayed for her. Tomorrow (I am writing these few words on Thursday 22nd) 23rd April is the birthday of Frederic Ozanam, who was born in 1813. He founded the St. Vincent de Paul Society 20 years later in Paris. All the members of St. Vincent de Paul Society all over the world will be remembering him with gratitude. And now 183 years later SVP is in nearly 150 countries with over 800,000 members worldwide. I take this opportunity to thank the members of the SVP - both senior and junior—in our parish for all the work they do. Of course we will also celebrate the feast of St. George the patron saint of England.

There were so many things that grabbed the attention, at least my attention, not to mention the campaigning for all kinds of elections both nearer home and far away. And I was reflecting on the presence of God in all these events, where is God in these situations. God is always with us and it is us who forget to recognize his loving presence with us in everything and in every moment of our lives—

in good moments and in moments of sadness, pain and hurt. I know it is difficult to understand it.

But then I read the homily of Pope Francis' morning homily at mass on Wednesday 21st at Santa Casa Marta. He said that "we must memorize the beautiful deeds God has worked in our lives. He stressed that our faith is made stronger when we recall all the key moments and signs which God has been active and present is us. We must look back to see how God has saved us, follow with hearts and minds this path.......It is good for the Christian heart to memorize my journey, my personal journey......Memory draws us close to God"

What a wonderful homily and thought not just for the day but for a lifetime! Those words of Pope Francis really gave me a real boost and they were another special invitation to a greater relationship with God. I would like to share those words of Pope Francis with you this weekend and invite you to respond to those words every day.

# Special Collection to promote humanitarian support for the needy of Ukraine

On the 3rd April, during his *Regina Cæli* address, Pope Francis asked that all Catholic Church in Europe take up a special collection for those who are suffering the consequences of violence in Ukraine. He said: "I invite the faithful to join in this initiative with a generous contribution. This act of charity, in addition to alleviating material suffering, seeks to express my personal closeness and solidarity and that of the entire Church."

Archbishop Peter asks that all Parishes take a second collection at Masses on the Sixth Sunday of Easter (30th April and 1st May). NB: This is one week later than the date chosen by Pope Francis, as a diocesan collection, for the maintenance of St George's Cathedral, is already in the calendar for that weekend. Parishes are asked to send a cheque to the Diocesan Finance Office as soon as possible after the collection is taken.
