Second Week of Lent: Jesus is transfigured

Look for the good

The disciples awoke from their doze and saw Jesus as he really was - transfigured, bright, full of light. How often do we miss the true essence of another person? This week, let's wake up and look for the brightness, the good, the divine in each person we meet.
