“NEW ALTAR SERVERS NEEDED!

We urgently need a large number of altar servers, to help with all our Sunday Masses, especially Saturday and Sunday evenings. We need at **least 20** new servers if at all possible to help cover all the masses as a number have left to go to College and University this year. Age is no barrier both **young people and adults equally welcome**. The only requirement is that you have made your First Holy Communion. Adults will need to complete a DBS check before being added to the Rota.

The Training Course for new servers begins on **Sunday 23 September at 12.30** in the Sacristy and will last for about 45 minutes. There are 8 sessions in all. The course enables those wishing to serve at Mass to get a basic understanding of the Mass itself and to get familiar with all the actions and skills required. All would be servers must complete the course before being admitted to the serving team.
