CARE OF CREATION

You will have seen from a recent newsletter that Saturday 1st September was celebrated as a day of prayer for the care of creation. This was inaugurated by the Pope in 2015, together with a month of prayer, ending on 4th October, the feast of St Francis of Assisi.

The Pope's encyclical 'Laudato Si' is all about care for creation, and draws inspiration from the writings of St. Francis. The text of this is accessible through our parish website, as follows: Click on parish groups, then Justice & Peace. Go to page 2 and you will find the text under 'various links' by clicking on Laudato Si. The book can also be purchased for £5.00 – CTS publication, enquire at the repository.

Water is one item that needs our special care. St. Francis described it as 'useful, humble, precious and chaste. We cannot live without it, nor must we waste it.

It is hoped to mention other aspects of care for creation in the coming weeks, up to 4th October Perhaps you can give this matter some thought, either individually or in groups.
