You will have seen from a recent newsletter that Saturday 1st September was celebrated as a day of prayer for the care of creation. This was inaugurated by the Pope in 2015, together with a month of prayer, ending on 4th October, the feast of St Francis of Assisi.

Francis of Assisi. The Pope's encyclical Laudato Si is all about care for creation, and draws inspiration from the writings of St. Francis. The text of this is accessible through our parish website. as follows: Click on parish groups, then Justice & Peace.
