Parish nursing enables the church to reach out to its community in a new way....through health ministry: helping people of all ages and backgrounds to enjoy better health, to use the health services more effectively, to manage any chronic conditions they have, to volunteer to help others, and to pray....sometimes for the first time. Parish nurses seek to do some joined up interventions for public health. Not dressings or injections, but health advice, advocacy and accompaniment. They are appointed or employed and

line-managed by the local church, for one or more sessions a week, which can be on a paid bases or just expenses only. They build good relationships with other health providers in the area especially GP practices, and with the church's pastoral team, offering extra help with understanding medical conditions, risk factors and treatments.
