COVID-19: A PARISH RESPONSE

All over the country, groups of volunteers are forming who want to help their neighbours during the present crisis of coronavirus. Now we are asking for volunteers for an OLI group to serve our fellow parishioners and other neighbours who live in the parish area. These may be elderly people but also much younger individuals whose health is compromised.

We are not asking for people to act as carers or handymen: the idea is simply to do little tasks that can no longer be done, or that are no longer advisable, for individuals who are isolated in their homes. Such tasks might include shopping, collecting a prescription or perhaps walking a dog.

A volunteer is advised not to enter a house if possible, but to stay at the doorway and speak to the occupant from a distance, delivering any requested items onto a floor or table where they can be picked up by the householder. Preserving the safety of householders is obviously of paramount importance, but so is the safety of volunteers.

If you are under 70 years old and in good health, please consider volunteering. The more helpers we have, the fewer visits will need to be made by each, and therefore the better chance of us all remaining well.

We also need to get a full picture of how many people will need this help. If you know someone who you think needs such help and who might be overlooked, please contact us.
