The area to clean is the entire building: carpeted areas need hoovering; tiled areas need sweeping and mopping; parquet wooden floors need sweeping. Walls, window shelfs, radiators, statues, pictures like to be dusted occasionally to get rid of cobwebs; brass likes to be polished occasionally. Toilets should be cleaned once a week. *Priests toilet and back door entrance: floor takes a long time to dry; it can take days!* Opening the side window could help, but warn priests if it's left open when you leave.
