What is a Christingle Service?

☆

A Christingle Service is a special Church Service that is held for children during Advent. The Service celebrates Christ, who is the Light of the World. **Children (and adults) are invited to bring a Christingle to the Service.**

What is a Christingle?

The Christingle consists of an orange, decorated with a red ribbon, sweets and/or dried fruits, in which is placed a small candle.

How do you make a Christingle?

- Take an orange and fasten some red ribbon/red tape around the middle
- Use an apple corer to make a hole at the top of the orange for a candle to sit in
- Skewer soft sweets and/or dried fruit onto 4 cocktail sticks so that the points are covered
- Arrange the loaded cocktail sticks evenly around the top of the orange to represent North,
 South, East and West
- You will be supplied with a candle to put into your orange when you come to the Christingle Service

What does the Christingle symbolise?

- The orange represents the world
- The red ribbon around it represents the blood of Christ
- The soft sweets and/or dried fruit skewered on cocktail sticks pushed into the orange, represent the **fruits of the earth** and the **four seasons**
- The lit candle pushed into the centre of the orange represents Christ as the Light of the World
