DESCRIPTION OF THE WORK

The work is to sweep the body of the church - called the Nave, and also to sweep and mop the vestibule entrance area called the Narthex and to Hoover all the carpeted areas. These places have a lot of footfall and need cleaning once a week.

Then there's the altar - called the Sanctuary, the Lady Chapel, the RDJ room, and the Sacristy areas where the priests and altar servers robe up and the inner Sacristy where stores are kept and the cleaning cupboard is located.

There are also extra jobs, being responsible for cleaning the buildings which are hired out to the public, that is: the Catholic Hall toilets (this used to be the school's responsibility but since 2022, it's been the parish's) and the Old Chapel. Individual cleaners are taking responsibility for these areas and so we need only clean them when these individuals are unable. Though they should be kept clean by those who hire them..

Apart from keeping the floors clean, there's also lots of dusting: window shelves, windows, statues, pictures, radiators, benches. Polishing candle sticks, & all the brass-wear, and the Stations of the Cross.

Some volunteers are not able to commit themselves to a Rota as they cannot reliably get that time off work and other commitments; they have opted to take responsibility for cleaning a particular area in their own time. This is a great help! The Sanctuary, the Choir loft, the Confessionals, the Lady Chapel, the internal windows, the Catholic Hall toilets and the Old Chapel are being cleaned by these volunteers.
