ABOUT CONFIRMATION

Confirmation is the Sacrament that completes your initiation into the Church, confirms your Baptism and enables you to be a witness to the Gospel. It is also a time when the whole community of Our Lady Immaculate Parish will pray for the Holy Spirit to fill your life. During the programme you will learn about the Sacrament of Confirmation and have the opportunity to choose to live and work as a member of the Catholic Church and be a follower and disciple of Jesus. The Bishop then calls you to the fullness of the Christian life. The Sacrament is <u>not</u> an opportunity to choose to no longer attend Mass.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

If you are in year 9 or above at school, or in college, have made your First Communion, and you <u>regularly</u> <u>come to Mass</u> in Our Lady Immaculate Parish, then you are eligible to be confirmed in this parish in 2026. Going to Mass regularly during the programme is very much part of the programme.

COMMITMENT TO THE COURSE

Year 9 is the ideal age, school commitments wise, to attend the confirmation course: it is a course, and all sessions must be attended in order for the Sacremanet to be received. There will be approx. 14 sessions over 5 and a bit months, but 100% commitment needs to be there from the start.

HOW TO JOIN:

Stage 1:

- 1. Print off this application pack and read through it carefully (please print each page on a <u>separate</u> sheet)
- 2. The application form (page one only) must be returned to the presbytery for my attention (or scanned to the email above which is perhaps preferable legible photos of forms are also ok via email) closing date for applications is Sunday 2nd November (late applications will not be accepted)
- 3. Your application will be acknowledged within a week of handing it in or being emailed to me (if you do not hear anything, please get in touch asap)

Stage 2:

- 1. Ensure you have a copy of the baptismal certificate (apply now to the parish where baptism took place for a copy if you need to)
- 2. Complete the Declaration of Commitment below
- 3. Complete the Sponsor Form below. This must be handed, as described on the form, to the sponsor and their Parish Priest to complete, and must be returned to you for point 5 below
- 4. Complete the GDPR form below
 - a. If you have all of the above and wish to hand them in / email them to me in advance of Point 5, then that would be great and save some time
- 5. We will email you after the above closing date, with a specific date for an appointment with one of our priests / myself so the application process can be completed (appointments will be late November, so please ensure ALL forms are fully complete before then) appointments to be attended by candidate and at least one parent. The above forms listed under Stage 2 should be brought with you to that meeting (unless handed in / emailed earlier, which would be great if you can), fully completed. Without all of the above, a young person cannot join the course

IMPORTANT DATES:

- The programme will run on Tuesdays at 7.15pm (finishing at 8.30pm) and run on most Tuesdays during term time. Candidates are expected to attend all sessions.
- Parents Meeting (not young people) will be held on Tuesday 13th January at 7.15pm for all parents (one per family is fine), and the course will start the week later for the young people. The rest of the dates will be provided after the sign up process is complete.
- The Sacrament of Confirmation will be conferred on Saturday 27th June at 11am.
