

The Parish Lenten Project (PLP) has been running successfully for over 40 years. The aim of the project is give the parish a **charitable focal point during Lent** and **give everyone** (all groups, clubs and societies) in the parish the opportunity to take part in **fundraising for good causes around the world.** 

The Lenten Project will support a maximum of **four charities per year**. The proceeds will be **split evenly** between the selected charities. Only **one charity will be supported per country**.

## **CRITERIA FOR SELECTING A CHARITY**

Here is an outline of the criteria that are used to select charities:

- 1. Direct help we looking for small charities/organisations rather than large established charities no intermediate organisations or government agencies
- 2. Confidence in the recipient we need to know that the money will be going directly to the charity
- 3. Value for money small and professionally run charity/organisation
- 4. Organisations that have small overheads we want to make sure that our money will make a real difference (not a large international NGO for example)
- 5. Is involved in supporting the poor, marginalised, or vulnerable.
- 6. Has a connection with someone in the OLI parish or school.
- 7. Operates with transparency and direct impact.
- 8. Faith-based or motivated by Christian values.
- 9. Only one charity will be supported per country per year
- 10. Only four charities will be supported per year
